Entrepreneurship let Nicholas leave his "day job" and eventually lead a company of 50 people earning a significant return for himself and his investors.

Seet enjoys sharing his knowledge and experience with anyone interested in pursuing entrepreneurship and encouraging people to follow their dreams. He is an experienced and dynamic speaker who has given talks at entrepreneur conferences at Rice University, Indiana University, UC Davis, and Harvey Mudd College. Students who enroll in the Intro to Entrepreneurship course will be introduced to the principles of entrepreneurship, gain hands-on practical skills, and learn from the experience of others. Seet plans to bring in various guest speakers and engage the class in goal-oriented exercises and small group discussions to supplement the reading assignments.
