

SUMMARY:

The Summer Bridge Program provides high school graduates and GED recipients an opportunity to take a selection of classes over the summer to transition gradually to college. The weekly meetings and educational activities assist students with tutoring and mentoring to strengthen their academic and college readiness skills.

PROGRAM BENEFITS:

- 1. Free to participants scholarships cover tuition and fees for the program.
- 2. Participate in a cohort of other first-time college students involved in academic courses.
- 3. Automatic consideration for Fall Bridge to Success Scholarship (no application required).
- 4. Receive personalized attention and advising from UNM-LA faculty and staff.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

This program and its associated scholarship are extremely competitive. Admission to the program is contingent upon the following. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

- 1. 2013 high school graduate or 2013 GED recipient.
- 2. Eligible for UNM-Los Alamos admission.
- 3. Complete a Summer Bridge Program Application Packet.
- 4. Once accepted into the program, meet with an advisor to register for the appropriate classes.
- 5. Participate in a mandatory orientation and weekly, outside of class session that will include enrichment, advisement and educational activities.

Priority Deadline April 19, 2013. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
