Proposed 2022-2023 Priorities, with identified action items.

- 1. Provide a safe environment for students, staff, faculty and visitors on campus
 - Develop, implement, and monitor health and safety protocols.
 - Use the improved security system to monitor campus safety.
 - Expand and document the relationship between UNM-LA and the Los Alamos Police Department.
- 2. Use an equity and inclusion lens to expand opportunity for faculty, staff, and students
 - Strengthen the equity and inclusion infrastructure across the campus.
 - Increase faculty and staff diversity, recruitment, retention, professional development, career advancement, and success.
 - Use Title V framework to create programming to provide sustained overarching, and holistic support of students from underrepresented racial/ethnic minority groups.

3. Provide students with a quality experience

- Provide appropriate professional development and technology to instructors and others who are delivering services.
- Systematically assess educational innovation.
- Gather and utilize qualitative and quantitative data to inform institutional responses.
- Strategically develop and market the programs we offer.
- Promote our commitment to customer service internally and externally.

4. Stabilize and increase enrollment

- Involve more faculty and staff in the process of developing, implementing, and monitoring recruiting and retention efforts. (Committees, Focus groups, etc.)
- Identify strategic target populations for recruiting efforts.
- Identify interests and needs of the current and prospective students.
- Develop curriculum, programs, and course schedules to meet the interests and needs of students.
- Design and implement new scholarship programs to attract target populations.
- Increase the number of students who are receiving scholarships and the total amount of scholarships awarded.

5. Strengthen collaborations with community and local workforce partners.

- Continue to collaborate with LANL on workforce initiatives such as the Mechanical Engineering, Nuclear Enterprise Science Technology (NEST), and Project Controls programs.
- Explore the expansion of Bachelor's opportunities such as Nursing and Education.
- Work with UNM-ABQ and the other branches on a Branch Strategy document to improve student transfer opportunities and explore additional efficiencies for the system.

6. Create long-term sustainability

- Use Title V grant to position campus for long term growth and future grant funding.
- Pursue additional funding through grants and alternative sources.
- Continue to grow the endowment for our campus.
