## **FIRST STEP IN STARTING A FAFSA FOR THE FIRST TIME:**

Create a FSA ID

The **FSA ID** is a username and password. It has replaced the Federal Student Aid PIN number and must be used to log in to certain US Department of Education websites. Your FSA ID confirms your identity when you access your financial aid information and **electronically sign Federal Student Aid documents like the FAFSA.**

If you are a dependent student you and one parent will need to create a FSA ID for each of you.

If you are an independent student you will only need a FSA ID for yourself.

**IMPORTANT: ONLY THE OWNER OF THE FSA ID SHOULD CREATE AND USE THE ACCOUNT. NEVER SHARE YOUR FSA ID.**


